# The Mid-Atlantic Workshop: Treating Children and Adolescents Who Stutter

**Objective:**

To provide speech-language pathologists with skills and practice to assess disfluency and to effectively treat stuttering in children and adolescents.

**Workshop Faculty:** Joseph Donaher, M.A. Children's Hospital of Philadelphia  
Lisa A. Scott, Ph.D. The Florida State University  
Kristin Chmela, M.A. Northwestern University

**Workshop Format:** This five-day workshop is presented through lectures, small group activities, videotape demonstrations, and discussion. Participants have the opportunity to practice new skills and to present their questions about their clients in a small group.

**Participants:** Twenty workshop participants are chosen from a variety of work settings, including schools, universities, hospitals, clinics, and private practice. Eligible applicants must hold ASHA Certificate of Clinical Competence, if in the U.S. University supervisors are eligible if they supervise fluency cases; instructors are eligible only if they actively engage in the supervision of fluency cases or private practice. We enjoy a diverse group; people in recent workshops came from 13 different states in the U.S., Japan, Israel, Thailand, Jamaica, Lebanon, and other locations.

**Costs:** The Stuttering Foundation will provide all conference fees and lodging costs, which includes a per diem for meals. Attendees are responsible for travel costs.

**Accommodations:** Workshop attendees will stay in single occupancy student dorm rooms in the same facility on the University of Pennsylvania campus. The workshop will begin on Wednesday, but rooms are reserved for the preceding Tuesday.

**Deadline:** All applications must be received by April 1, 2008. All applicants will be contacted during the last week of April with the decision of the admissions committee.

**Continuing Education:** The Stuttering Foundation of America is approved by the Continuing Education Board of the American Speech-Language-Hearing Association (ASHA) to provide continuing education activities in speech-language pathology and audiology. This program is offered for 2.9 CEUs (Advanced Level, Professional Area). ASHA CE Provider approval does not imply endorsement of course content, specific products, or clinical procedures.
